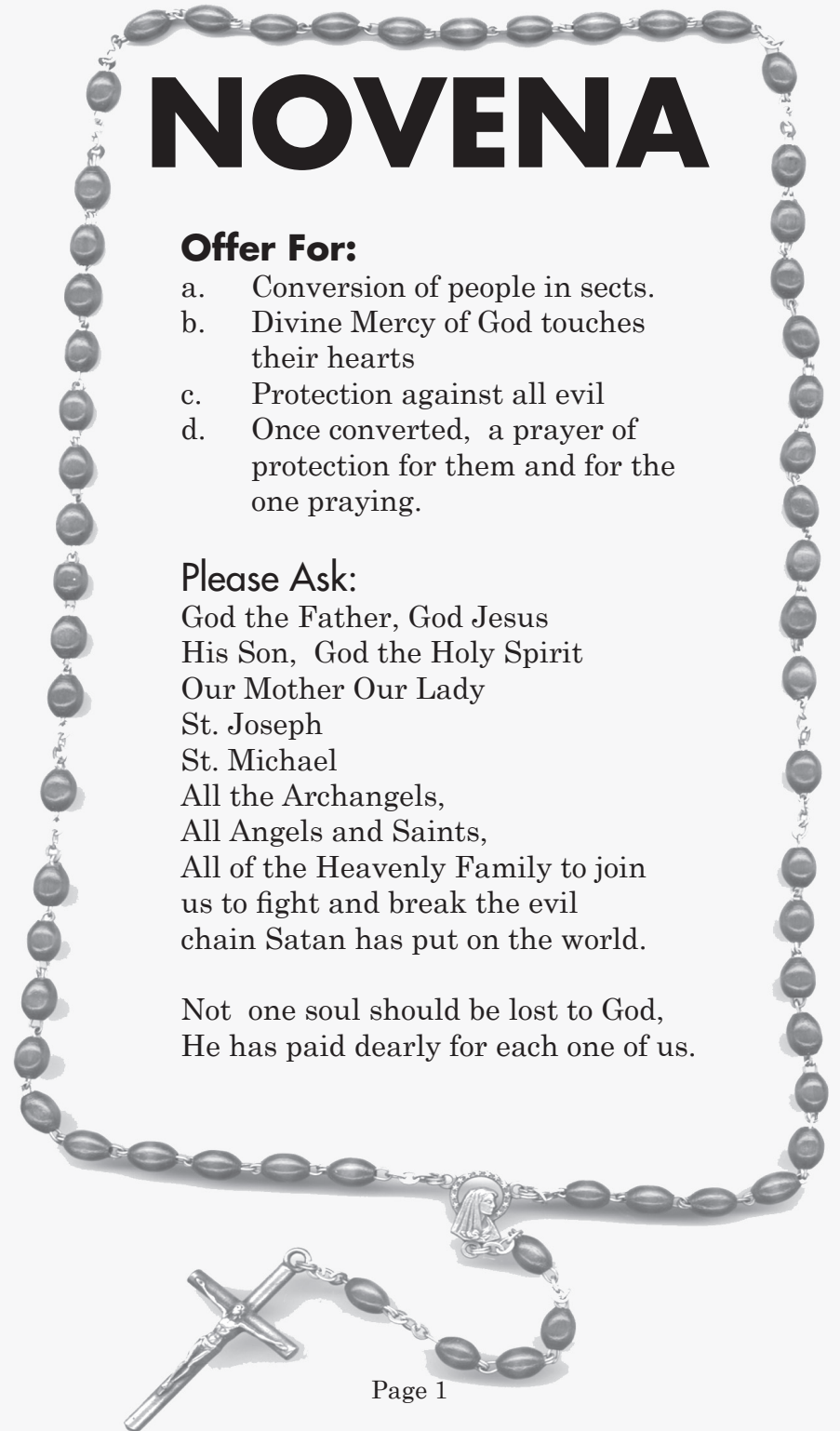

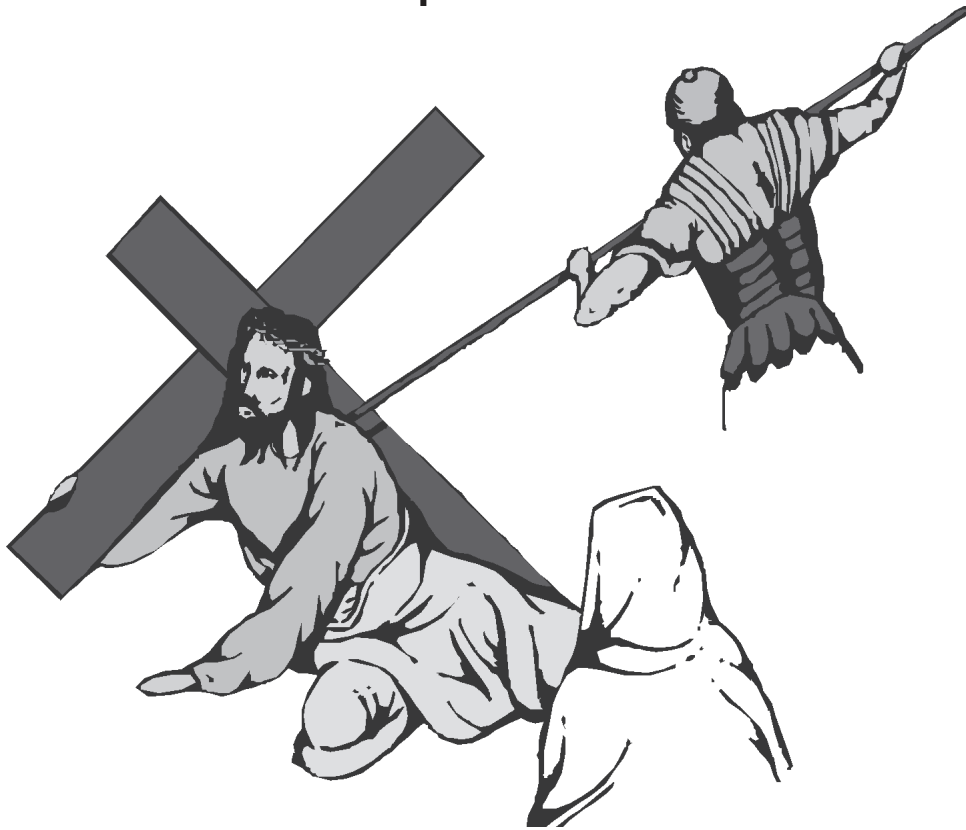

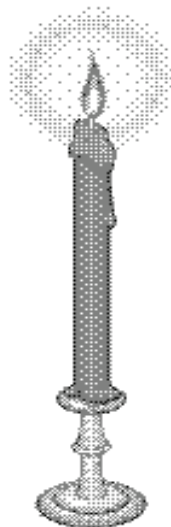
Prayer to St. Michael the Archangel

Iwould like to tell you why this Novena has been put together.

In March 2000 I had a dream when I was standing with Our Lady and Satan in the middle of the street. I was arguing with Satan. I turned my back on him when Our Holy Mother called out "You must strike now Maria!" I turned and struck Satan. Our Holy Mother with a thin near invisible golden thread bound Satan. I cried out, "We have won the battle!" Our Lady remained with Satan.

Walking further up the street, I looked up to the sky and called out "God, Lord we have won the battle". The thunder came from Heaven and the sky opened and Jesus appeared. I fell on my back on the road. I said: "Lord, we have won the battle." A bright beam of light came from Heaven and hit the earth. It came over me and in that instant I was in great agony. It only lasted an instant and Jesus said: "This is the light of purification." And as it passed on all human beings, all evil had gone.

Our Lady had asked me to "strike" and I didn't know how or what I should do. It came to me that beside the Mass, which is the most powerful weapon we have, I should put together the most powerful prayers, The Rosary for Conversion, The Divine Mercy Chaplet; that God's Love and Mercy will touch hearts and souls so they can see the true light of God. Also the Chaplet of Protection and Healing, protection for ourselves.

On a Rosary, pray:-

(On the Crucifix)

THE APOSTLE'S CREED

(The on the large bead after the Crucifix)

Our Father, etc

(on the three following small beads)

1. Hail Mary, etc - In praise of God the Father
2. Hail Mary, etc - In petition
3. Hail Mary, etc - In thanksgiving, with confidence that our petition will be granted.

(On all the Gloria beads)

Holy God, Holy Omnipotent One, save us who dwell in this land.

(Each decade, on each of the 10 small beads)

Jesus Saviour, Merciful Saviour, spare your people.

(At the end of the fifth decade)

Son of God, Eternal Son, thank you for the things you have done. (three times)



CHAPLET OF MERCY (cont)

(Then on the large bead before each decade)

Eternal Father,

I offer you the Body and Blood. Soul and Divinity of your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

(On the ten small beads of each decade, say)

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and the whole world.

(Conclude with)

Holy God
Holy Mighty One,
Holy Immortal One,
have mercy on us and on the whole world. (Three times)

(Closing Prayer)

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion - inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your Holy Will, which is Love and Mercy itself. (950)

OPENING PRAYER

Act of Consecration To the Immaculate Heart of Mary

(St. Louis de Montfort's Consecration)

I (name) a faithless sinner renew and ratify today in thy hands, O Immaculate Mother, the vows of my Baptism; I renounce forever Satan, his pomps and works; and I give myself entirely to Jesus Christ, the Incarnate Wisdom, to carry my cross after Him all the days of my life, and to be more faithful to Him than I have ever been before.

In the presence of all the heavenly court I choose thee this day for my Mother and mistress. I deliver and consecrate to thee as thy slave, my body and soul, my goods, both interior and exterior, and even the value of all my good actions, past present and future; leaving to thee the entire and full right of disposing of me, and all that belongs to me, without exception, according to thy good pleasure, for the greater glory of God, in time and in eternity. Amen.

(Then conclude the Pilgrim Virgin prayers with the following aspirations)

Sacred Heart of Jesus, have pity on us!
Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart of Mary, Pray for us and save us!
Jesus, Mary, I love you! Save souls.
O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to Thee.
Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us now and at the hour of our death.
Sweet Heart of Mary, be my salvation.
St. Joseph, pray for us.
